Hapu Hui – Ngapuhi	Erin spoke to the latest proposal dated 7 September 2018.	
Treaty Settlement	It was noted that this proposal had only been released the day before which allowed for little time to prepare given this hui was predicated by original proposal being the only document to be presented.	
	 Feedback on new presentation dated 7 September 2018 The presentation was far too long. It is difficult to understand the actual structure proposed given chart appears midway through the presentation. There was confusion in interpreting content of the slides relating to rejection and support for urban, KK, Runanga (which could mean we take an incorrect interpretation). Some hapu members who had attended roadshows question the accuracy of the summary of key feedback. Prospect of hapu receiving an initial grant appears to be a positive development as does commercial dividend sharing agreement with regions. Confusion exists between proposals relating to first round of hui and second overlapping given some hapu have still not had planned hui relating to first proposal, e.g. Bill advised that he was asked to organise a Ngapuhi Treaty Settlement Hui at Oromahoe Marae on Friday 14 September (11:30am to 1:30pm). This hui does not appear on the proposed schedule of hui on the latest presentation. Agreed beneficial to have time to read through new proposal then hold hui with technical advisors present to clarify concerns and prepare a considered submission. 	
	 Moving Forward Encourage hapu members to attend an upcoming local hui as noted in presentation. Agreed to advertise these dates/presentation to the hapu via FB/website. Following this round of Hui, hapu to meet (proposed date Saturday 20 October) to prepare a more considered view of the proposal. Erin to confirm if 20 October would still allow Ngare Hauata submission to be accepted and if so, seek availability of Technical team to attend hui. Erin to report back if date needs to be changed to meet these conditions.
